The purpose of the league is to offer an introduction to wrestling competition, at a recreational level, for all Clark County residents. It is designed to be inclusive of all abilities. The program focuses on development of wrestling skills along with good sportsmanship, character development and strong work ethics. Our coaches are passionate about the sport and will share their enthusiasm with all wrestlers. Wrestlers of all levels are welcome to join.

Who: Boys & girls in grades 1-8

Wrestlers will work with kids their ability/size/age.

When: Dec 17 – Mar 2, Mon & Wed, 5:30-6:45 or 7-8:30 PM
(Practice time determined by grade – you will be notified once registration is closed and groups divided)

Where: View Ridge/Sunset Ridge Auxiliary Gym/Wrestling Room

Extras: Students will be offered 2-4 dual meets in Jan/Feb.
RHS will host one meet. The other meets could be at any participating school in Clark County.

Parents provide transportation.

Jamboree: All wrestlers are invited to participate in the final Jamboree, March 1 & 2

Attire: Kids should wear comfortable clothing that allows them to move – no jeans.
Wrestling shoes are recommended, but not required.
